9. **Inclusion of Members of Parliament in State and district level committees:** Members of Parliament (MP) and Member of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) have been included in the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the committee for MsDP. MLAs are also to be nominated on the Committees by the State Government. It should be ensured that they are invited to attend the meetings of the district and State level committees.

10. **Display boards:** Para 16.1(ii) of the scheme of MsDP provides for a 'display board' which should have- Name of the project/scheme printed followed by "Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India." For projects with longer construction period, in addition to above, the name of implementing agency, date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion and estimated cost of the project should be printed on the display boards. States/UT should ensure this and put up a permanent display on completion of each project.

11. General conditions applicable to projects approved by the Empowered Committee

For approvals given by the Empowered Committee, including in-principle approvals, the Principal Secretary/Secretary of State's/UTs and the District Collectors/representatives were advised to note that the following conditions would apply to all projects under MsDP. State Government/UT administration concerned should ensure that the following have been complied with:-

**Approval of the State department concerned/Mission Director** for Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) concerned have covered the following –

- (a) **Need** for having the proposal sanctioned under MsDP.
- (b) Duplication has been eliminated.
- (c) Proposal is as per norms, specifications, layout design, funding norms and cost norms of the CSS guidelines concerned.
- (d) **Separate accounts for schemes under MsDP will be maintained** and details sent to the Central Ministry concerned for maintaining proper record of assets and avoiding double counting and duplication.
- (e) Estimates have been prepared as per Schedule of Rates (SOR) of the State Government and have been approved by a competent engineering department of the State Govt.
- (f) **Staff is available** for functioning unit or will be provided for new unit.
- (g) **Recurring expenditure** would be provided by the State Government.



(h) Land is available and/or will be made available by the State Government in villages/locations having the highest proportion (percentage) of minority population.

12. **Review meetings of Oversight committee in State and district level committees:** The scheme of MsDP envisages quarterly review meetings by the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the review committees for MsDP. The State level committee also acts as the Oversight Committee for MsDP. Quarterly review meetings for State level committee/State Oversight Committee and district level Committee should be held and copy of the meeting notice should be sent to the Ministry to enable a representative to attend State Level meetings as envisaged under MsDP. It should be ensured that Members of Parliament nominated in such Committees are invited to attend the meetings.

13. **Photographs:** Photographs of completed works and works in progress indicating type of asset, name of location/village and date should be sent by email to **shubhendu.ss@nic.in**.

14. **Provision of toilets and bathrooms :** The EC emphasized that there should be adequate number of toilets and bathrooms and provision of water in the proposed projects.

15. The Chairman (EC) emphasized that the benefits accrued by the implementation of MsDP should go to the Minority Communities properly. Therefore, not only location of the assets in the areas having substantial minority population is important, but it is also equally important to see that the assets created are actually imparting benefits to the minorities. The State Governments were impressed upon to propose the locations of projects under MsDP accordingly.

#### **A. Bihar**

The State Govt. of Bihar has submitted project proposals in respect of Araria, Darbhanga, Purnea, Katihar, Siwan, Sitamarhi, Nawada, Patna, Rohtas, Samastipur and Nalanda districts for implementation of MsDP during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan under restructured MsDP. The State Govt. has submitted the declaration in appendix-II of guidelines of MsDP for all the projects:-

- I. The **cost estimates proposed** for the different works/projects are **as per the standardized cost** derived on the basis of norms/design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work.
- II. It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have at least 25 % enrolment of the minority students.



- III. It has been ensured that there is no duplication of the work with any scheme of the Central Government or a State Government and the concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- IV. The land for all construction activities is available.
- V. The maintenance and the recurring cost related to the assets proposed in this plan will be borne by the State Govt.
- VI. The Plan proposal has been recommended by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.


The details of project discussed by the EC are as follows:-

**Construction of Girls ITI:** - The State Govt. officials informed that the Construction of Girls ITIs at Nawada and Katihar have been proposed at the cost of Rs1426.00 and Rs.1486.00 respectively. It was also clarified that the ITIs are as per NCVT norms. The ITI will have 4 trades in the beginning. Component –wise abstract of cost was also provided.

The EC went through the abstract of cost and was of the opinion that the cost is a bit on higher side. The representative of Ministry of Skill Development observed that the proposal consist of staff hostel, canteen block, principal residence, vise- principal residence, boundary wall etc. apart from the institutional building and workshop which is the only component admissible under NCVT norms. Hence the cost is high. The EC discussed the matter with the state government officials and it was decided to consider the cost of Institutional Building and Workshop only. The Director Technical Education of the state government elaborated that this cost consist of IMC building and Examination Hall. The representative of Ministry of Skill development suggested to subtract the cost of IMC Building, Auditorium and Examination Hall and consider the proposal.

The EC directed the state government to work out the cost of Institutional Building and Workshop excluding IMC building and Examination Hall and intimate the Ministry for consideration of the proposal.

**Construction of 50 bedded & 100 bedded Hostel:** Two types of hostels have been proposed (a) 100 bedded hostels at the cost of Rs.273.54 lakh and (b) 50 bedded at the cost of Rs.240.18 lakh. The State Govt. provided abstract of cost with the area of construction. During discussion, the representative of Ministry of HRD briefed the committee that as per RMSA norms for the state of Bihar, the cost of 100 bedded hostel comes around Rs 171.00 lakh. Therefore the proposed costs are on higher side. The state government representative proposed that hostels may be approved at the earlier approved costs of hostels by the Empowered Committee. The state expressed his readiness to bear any extra cost above the approved cost. But the EC directed the state government to go through the estimate again and revise it on the line of RMSA.



However, the EC approved the Construction of 50 bedded & 100 bedded Hostel in principle because these assets are essential for education sector. Money to be released after revised estimates are approved by the E.C.

**Construction of High School /Upgradation of Middle school into High School:** The State Govt. has submitted the proposal of construction of new high school/upgradation of middle school at the cost of Rs.142.71 lakh. The representative of State Govt. (Principal Secretary) informed the committee that the State Govt. has decided to construct a new high school or to upgrade middle school into high school in each Panchayat of the State. In both the cases the structure is the same. The representative of RMSA observed that in case of upgradation the cost may be less than the cost involved in a new construction. Upon this, the State Govt. proposed the approval of projects at the earlier approved costs of high schools by the Empowered Committee. But the EC directed the state government to go through the estimate again and revise it properly.

However, the EC approved the Construction of high schools in principle because these assets are essential for education sector. Further, the MoHRD officials informed that if the school is upto +2 level, the distance should normally be 5 kilometers between two (+2) level schools. It was decided by EC that State should ensure this and also money will be released after revised estimates are approved by the E.C.

**Construction of Primary Health Center/Additional Primary Health Center (PHC/APHC) and Health sub Center (HSC) at the cost of Rs.124.31 lakh and Rs.23.86 lakh:** The State Govt. has submitted the proposals for construction of PHC/APHC and HSC. The Empowered Committee wanted to know the difference between PHC and APHC. The State representative explained that normally there is one PHC in one block in Bihar. If it is required to construct another PHC in the block, it is called APHC in Bihar. In both the cases the structure is same. APHCs and HSCs have been approved by NRHM.

The representative from Ministry of Health and family Welfare, briefed the committee that the area of PHC/APHC should be 375-450 sqm. and the approximate cost may be around Rs.130.00 lakh. Approximate cost of HSC may be around Rs. 28-30 lakh. The present cost of Rs.124.31 lakh for PHC/APHC and Rs.23.86 lakh for HSC may be considered.

The EC agreed to the proposal and also agreed to the release of 50 % of central share as 1<sup>st</sup> installment for the project.

**Unit Cost of Additional Class Rooms:-** with due discussion and observation of the representative of RMSA, the EC agreed to the cost of ACRs @ Rs.7.20 lakh, Library @ Rs.10.00 lakh and common room @ Rs.15.00 lakh.

The EC decided to approve the following projects. The EC also decided to release the 1<sup>st</sup> installment of maximum upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the projects:-

## B. Manipur

### A. Proposals of Manipur

The State Govt of Manipur has submitted project proposals in respect of Imphal East for implementation of MsDP during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. The proposal has been recommended by the State Level Committee (SLC) for PM's new 15 PP as per the guidelines. The proposal has been accompanied by Appendix-II of the guidelines. The Appendix-II contains the following declarations of State Government:

- The **land** for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that **all locations proposed have atleast 25% minority population** in its catchment area.
- The **Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost** derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work



- **No duplication of the work** with any Scheme of the Center /State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- Maintenance and recurring cost related will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposal has been approved by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.

**The detail of project is discussed below:**

**Construction of School Building including compound fencing at Netaji High School at the cost of Rs. 74.89 lakh:**

The state government has proposed construction of 10 units of ACRs alongwith two toilets, varandha, main entrance and compound wall in existing Netaji High School. It is a govt. high school having class III to X standard. There are 536 students in the school.

The area of the proposed structure is 540.22 sqm. and compound wall of 169.10 rmts. The plinth area rate is Rs. 13,207.64 for the building and cost of compound wall is Rs. 2092 per running mts. The total cost of construction is Rs. 74.89 lakhs excluding agency charge and other leviabale taxes. The lay out map has been submitted.

The structure would have RCC foundation, brick walls, plaster on both sides plastic emulsion paints and outer wall with water proof paint, CGI roofing with proper slope. It has been also stated by the State that land for construction is available. The post of teachers and other related posts have been sanctioned. **The EC agreed to the present proposals**

**Construction of Girls Hostel at Netaji High School at the cost of 71.35 lakh:**

The state government has proposed construction of 36 bedded girls' hostel at Netaji High School. The hostel will consist of 12 rooms of 3 seater each along with one recreation hall, one dining hall, warden room, office room, kitchen, 9 toilets, 6 bathrooms, staircase, varandha and porch.

The area of the proposed structure is 287.43sqm. The plinth area rate is Rs.13,207.64 per sqm for the building. The total cost of construction is Rs. 71.35 lakhs excluding agency charge and other leviabale taxes. The lay out map has been submitted. The hostel will have two floors.

The structure would have RCC foundation, brick walls, plaster on both sides plastic emulsion paints and outer wall with water proof paint, CGI roofing with proper slope. It has been also stated by the State that land for construction is available. **The EC agreed to the present proposals.**



**Construction of PHC Building at Jiribam at the cost of 78.36 lakh:**

The state government has proposed construction of PHC building at Jiribam. Land is available without any encumbrance. The PHC will consist of 3 patient rooms, 1 staff room, 1 Doctor room and 1 Dressing room with toilet.

The area of the proposed structure is 221.34sqm. The plinth area rate is Rs. 35,406.16 per sqm for the building. The total cost of construction is Rs. 78.36 lakhs excluding agency charge and other leviable taxes. The lay out map has been submitted. Post of Doctors and Nurses have been sanctioned in the standard norms- 5-Doctores, 3-Nurses, 1-Male Health Worker, 2-Paramedic staffs, 1-UDc and 1-LDC.

The structure would have RCC foundation, brick walls, plaster on both sides plastic emulsion paints and outer wall with water proof paint, **RCC Slab Roof** with proper slope. It has been also stated by the State that land for construction is available.

The EC wanted to know whether this is a totally new construction or the construction will be done after demolition of the existing structure. Further if the construction has been proposed after demolition of the existing structure, whether the structure was old enough to be demolished and whether any certification for demolition has been obtained. The representative of Ministry of Health and Family welfare also noticed that area proposed for the PHC is less than the area prescribed for it i.e 375-450 sqm. The EC also observed that the cost of construction was also high.

The State representative informed that a new PHC will be constructed after demolition of existing PHC.

The EC directed the State Govt. to obtain the certification for demolition from CPWD/PWD and the estimation of cost should be done as per the cost norms of CPWD and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

**Construction of Type-III Quarter (G+2), 12 unit per block at Yambem PHC and Andro PHC at the cost of 342.07 lakh:**

The State Govt. has submitted this proposed Type-III Quarter (G+2) at Yambam PHC and Andro PHC. From the abstract of cost and the maps provided by the State, it appears that there are 24 bedrooms in 6 quarters.

The area of the proposed structure is 956.49 sqm. The plinth area rate is Rs. 35,763.05 per sqm. for the building. The total cost of construction is Rs. 342.07 lakhs excluding agency charge and other leviable taxes. The lay out map has been submitted.

The structure would have RCC foundation, brick walls, plaster on both sides plastic emulsion paints and outer wall with water proof paint, **RCC Slab Roof** with proper slope.

However the EC observed that the Cost of construction is very high. The EC directed that the estimate should be revised as per CPWD norms and a certificate of CPWD to this effect should also be submitted. The EC also wanted to know whether residential quarters already existed in the PHC or not.

**Construction of Undergraduate Girls Hostel at Top Chingitha at the cost of Rs,917.80 lakh:**

The state government has proposed construction of Undergraduate Girls Hostel at Top Chingitha. The capacity of the hostel is not known. It appears that it is G+1 structure. The hostel has 28 double bedded room, one common room, dining hall, toilets etc.

The area of the proposed structure is 1472.92sqm. The plinth area rate has not been mentioned in the abstract of cost. The total cost of construction given in the proposals is Rs.917.80 lakhs excluding agency charge and other leviabale taxes. The lay out map has been submitted.

The structure would have RCC foundation, brick walls, plaster on both sides plastic emulsion paints and outer wall with water proof paint, CGI roofing with proper slope.

The EC observed that the Cost of construction is very high the EC directed that the estimate should be revised as per CPWD norms and a certificate of CPWD to this effect should also be submitted.

The EC agreed to the following proposals and also agreed to the release of 50% of Central Share as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment.

## C. UTTAR PRADESH

### A). Change of location for project approved by 96<sup>th</sup> EC.

The 96<sup>th</sup> Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 24.03.2016 approved a project of Holistic Educational Solution for improved learning outcomes and educational qualities in 300 Government Schools of Uttar Pradesh at the total cost of Rs.3077.74 lakh. The 1<sup>st</sup> installment for the project i.e. Rs.553.93 lakh was issued on 21.04.2015.

2. The project was approved as a innovative and pilot project. The sharing ratio of the expenditure was approved as 60:40 between Central Government and State Government. The Government of Uttar Pradesh in its project proposal sent a list of 400 schools with the approval of State Level Committee for the above project. The 300 schools selected by EC were amongst the 400 schools recommended by SLC.

3. The State Government has now requested for change of 82 venue (schools) on various grounds. The common reasons for change are non-availability of basic infrastructure for implementation of project. The State has submitted a list of alternative location and stated these locations are also approved by SLC on 28.01.2015.

4. The alternate location proposed by State list has been checked and it is found that out of 82 location, 6 location are outside Minority Concentration Town. The detail is at annexure-I. The Empowered Committee based on the discussion with State Government officials and documents furnished by State agreed for change of 76 location as proposed by the State subject to following condition:-

- (i). The catchment area of new location is having at least 25% population of Minority Communities.
- (ii). The alternate location i.e. School proposed are Government owned.
- (iii). The approval of State Level Committee for 15 PP has been obtained for alternate location.
- (iv). The alternate location have all facilities for implementation of above project.

6. The Empowered Committee also requested the State to submit alternate location for remaining 6 dropped school.
