MINUTES OF THE 122nd MEETING OF EMPOWERED COMMITTEE UNDER MULTI-SECTORAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON 16.12.2016 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY, MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

The 122nd Meeting of the Empowered Committee (EC) for Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) was held on 16.12.2016, under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs to consider and approve the project proposals with regard to the Minority Concentration Blocks/Towns received from State Governments of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Assam, Andhra Pradesh, and Bihar. The representatives of the Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation, NAWADCO, Arunachal Pradesh (Pr. Secretary, Dy. RC) and Ministry of Human Resource Development attended the meeting. The State representative of Andhra Pradesh(Commissioner, Minority Welfare), Manipur(Pr. Secretary, Director), Bihar(Pr. Secretary) and district representative of Assam and others States also attended the meeting through video conferencing.

- 2. Progress on website: The progress of implementation of MsDP is reported on quarterly basis to the Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in PMO (Prime Minister's Office) and the status of implementation of various projects in terms of funds released by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and utilized by the State/UT; number of works sanctioned, completed and works in progress is regularly monitored. These details of works are placed in the Ministry's website for transparency. State Governments/UT Administrations are required to review the implementation on quarterly basis; ensure that Central funds are released to the districts within one month of sanction; State share (wherever applicable) released along with the Central funds; ensure that the executing agencies start the construction works at the earliest, and complete the construction works within the scheduled period.
- 3. Adhering to guidelines and eliminating duplication: States/UTs should ensure that the proposals sent have the approval of the State Level Committee of MsDP / Mission Director of CSS concerned in order to ensure that the proposal, in terms of specification, norms, standards etc., is in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme concerned and that duplication has been ruled out. The responsibility for eliminating duplication of work and avoiding double counting of a scheme under two funding sources vested with both the district authority and the State Government. Accounts under MsDP should be maintained separately and Central Ministry concerned informed of assets created in respect of CSS topped up under MsDP.
- 4. The States/UTs were advised by the Empowered Committee to ensure that the catchment area of the assets created under MsDP have substantial minority population. Further the States/UTs would also ensure that the ownership of the asset created would be with the Govt/Govt body.
- 5. <u>Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) guidelines:</u> MsDP provides that there would be no change in guidelines of any existing Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) under implementation in such districts for which this programme would provide additional funds. In case schemes for



individual benefits are taken up under the programme, there shall be no divergence from existing norms for selection of beneficiaries from the list of BPL families in the district, so that benefits from the additional funds flow to all BPL families and not selectively. However, the provision under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) guidelines for making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST) will not be followed under MsDP. The entire number of units sanctioned under MsDP would be given to BPL households, from minority communities as well as other communities, in order of the serial number in the approved wait list without making separate allocation for Scheduled Castes (SC) or Scheduled Tribes (ST).


- 6. <u>Timely release of funds:</u> The sanction letters of the Ministry stipulate that funds should be released to the district/implementing agency within a month's time, but the States/UT have been generally taking much time in releasing funds to the district/implementing agency. State shares, wherever applicable, are not released along with the Central funds by some States. Prompt release of funds was advised to ensure that works are started at the earliest.
- 7. <u>Utilization Certificate:</u> For release of second installment, utilization certificate (UC) is required. If the UC is furnished within a period of one year after release by the Ministry, 60% UC would be required for releasing the next installment. However, if utilization is made beyond the period of a year, 100% utilization would be necessary. The UCs would need to be accompanied by QPR showing physical progress as proof of the work in progress. The Utilization Certificates of the 2nd and subsequent installment should also be submitted by the States/UTs to the Ministry.
- 8. <u>Sample testing and quality control</u>: Quality control was to be ensured through regular and frequent field visits and by testing samples of the construction work for which funds would be sanctioned by the Ministry on receipt of request from the State concerned. All the States/UTs were advised to carry out field visits, quality control tests and review all works under MsDP to ensure that the shortcomings do not take place in their State/UT.
- 9. <u>Inclusion of Members of Parliament in State and district level committees:</u> Members of Parliament (MP) and Member of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) have been included in the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the committee for MsDP. MLAs are also to be nominated on the Committees by the State Government. It should be ensured that they are invited to attend the meetings of the district and State level committees.
- 10. <u>Display boards:</u> Para 16.1(ii) of the scheme of MsDP provides for a 'display board' which should have— Name of the project/scheme printed followed by "Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP), Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India." For projects with longer construction period, in addition to above, the name of implementing agency, date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion and estimated cost of the project should be printed on the display boards. States/UT should ensure this and put up a permanent display on completion of each project.
- 11. General conditions applicable to projects approved by the Empowered Committee for approvals given by the Empowered Committee, including in-principle approvals, the Principal Secretary/Secretary of State's/UTs and the District Collectors/representatives were advised to note

that the following conditions would apply to all projects under MsDP. State Government/UT administration concerned should ensure that the following have been complied with:-

<u>Approval of the State department concerned/Mission Director</u> for Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) concerned have covered the following –

- (a) Need for having the proposal sanctioned under MsDP.
- (b) Duplication has been eliminated.
- (c) Proposal is as per norms, specifications, layout design, funding norms and cost norms of the CSS guidelines concerned.
- (d) <u>Separate accounts for schemes under MsDP will be maintained</u> and details sent to the Central Ministry concerned for maintaining proper record of assets and avoiding double counting and duplication.
- (e) Estimates have been prepared as per Schedule of Rates (SOR) of the State Government and have been approved by a competent engineering department of the State Govt.
- (f) Staff is available for functioning unit or will be provided for new unit.
- (g) Recurring expenditure would be provided by the State Government.
- (h) Land is available and/or will be made available by the State Government in villages/locations having the highest proportion (percentage) of minority population.
- 12. Review meetings of Oversight committee in State and district level committees: The scheme of MsDP envisages quarterly review meetings by the State and district level committees for implementation of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities which also serves as the review committees for MsDP. The State level committee also acts as the Oversight Committee for MsDP. Quarterly review meetings for State level committee/State Oversight Committee and district level Committee should be held and copy of the meeting notice should be sent to the Ministry to enable a representative to attend State Level meetings as envisaged under MsDP. It should be ensured that Members of Parliament nominated in such Committees are invited to attend the meetings.
- 13. <u>Photographs:</u> Photographs of completed works and works in progress indicating type of asset, name of location/village and date should be sent by email to <u>shubhendu.ss@nic.in</u>.
- 14. <u>Provision of toilets and bathrooms</u>: The EC emphasized that there should be adequate number of toilets and bathrooms and provision of water in the proposed projects.
- 15. The Chairman (EC) emphasized that the benefits accrued by the implementation of MsDP should go to the Minority Communities properly. Therefore, not only location of the assets in the areas having substantial minority population is important, but it is also equally important to see that the assets created are actually imparting benefits to the minorities. The State Governments were impressed upon to propose the locations of projects under MsDP accordingly.



(A), Andhra Pradesh

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted project proposals for construction of 6 Residential School Complexes at the cost of Rs 22.00 crore each, construction of 4 Sadbhav Mandap with cost range of Rs. 120-235 crores, and 1 Multi-purpose Community Centre for Rs. 150 crores.

- 2. The state has submitted following declaration as prescribed in Appendix II of the guidelines:-
- The land for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that all locations proposed have atleast 25% minority population in its catchment area.
- It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have atleast 25% enrolment of the minority students.
- The Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work
- No duplication of the work with any Scheme of the Center /State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- Maintenance and recurring cost related will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposal has been approved by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.
- 2. The above proposals were considered by 121st meeting of Empowered Committee. The Empowered Committee observed the location of the projects must be in the identified Minority Concentration Area i.e MCB & MCTs. The projects proposed by the State for area other than identified area was not agreed by the Empowered Committee. Based on the observation of the EC, the State vide their letter No. 6835/EDM/A2/2014 dated 12.12.2016 submitted the revised proposals. The details of the revised proposals are as under:
 - (i) Construction of Residential School Complex for Boys and Girls: The State has submitted proposal for C/o 5 nos. of Residential School Complexes in Anantapuramu, Guntur and Kadapa districts. The State confirmed that the rates are worked out based on current SSR i.e. Building SSR 2015-16. The State has submitted the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the project. The EC agreed to the projects.
 - (ii). C/o Sadbhav Mandap: The State has submitted proposal for C/o 3 nos. of Sadbhav Mandap. The Empowered Committee considered the layout proposed by the State. It was conveyed by one of the District representative that the proposed structure will contain two rooms & toilets at each floor. The EC observed that the proposed assets lack provision for activities like sports, local fair, exhibition etc. The EC directed the State representative to recast their proposals and includes provisions for activities related to cultural, economical, sports and disaster managements. It was suggested by EC that the proposed structure should contain toilets outside the main structure.

(B). Arunachal Pradesh

The Ministry has received projects for Minority Concentration Blocks of Arunachal Pradesh. It has been conveyed by the State Govt. vide letter No. DSJE-57/2016/MsDP (P) dated that 82 nos of various proposals have been approved by the SLC in its meeting held on 02.11.2016. The State has submitted the DPR of the projects and following declaration in Appendix-II of the guidelines:

- The land for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that all locations proposed have atleast 25% minority population in its catchment area.
- It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have atleast 25% enrolment of the minority students.
- The Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work
- No duplication of the work with any Scheme of the Center /State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- Maintenance and recurring cost related will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposal has been approved by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme/ SLSSC.
- 2. The Empowered Committee considered various types of projects viz. construction of AWC, Class Room, Hostels, Multi-purpose Hall, Teaching Aids, Water Supply, Health Centres submitted by State of Arunachal Pradesh on following parameters:-
 - (i). The catchment area of the projects must have substantial Minority Population.
 - (ii) . The projects should be as per norms of line Ministers.
 - (iii). School where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have atleast 25% enrolment of the minority students
 - (iv). The State should ensure that the asset to be created is utilized optimum.
 - (v). The cost of each project must be justified and must not be more than the amount sanctioned by the line Ministry for similar projects.
 - (vi). The project proposed should be in accordance with real need of area.
 - (vii). The project must have details about its components and justification for each component.

- 3. Based on above parameters, the EC discussed each and every project with the representative of State Government. The EC observed that in many cases, the proposals do not have adequate justification for higher cost and requirement. Though the State vide their letter no.DSJE-57/2016(MsDP)/P dated 15.12.2016 assured the Ministry for optimum utilization of asset and also assured that they will constitute hostels management committee for each asset, the EC observed that concrete proposals in this regards may be presented before it alongwith other requisite details. The representative of State desired that the Ministry may convey the reason for non-acceptance for each and every project so that a revised/rectified proposal can be submitted by the State.
- 4. The representative of State was apprised of cost calculation in one of the project wherein the cost of 7 project from Rs.70 lakh(for 6 units) was enhanced to Rs. 107 lakh on next page by dividing Rs. 70 lakh by four(4) and then multiplying the resultant by six. Whereas, Rs.70 lakh should have been divided by Six(6) and not by four(4) to work out unit cost and thereafter again by Six(6) on the next page to work out total cost for 6 units. The representative of State had requested to separately send it to the State for appropriate action from their side. It was decided to forward the same to State for further action.
- 4. Based on above, the EC approved the following projects and decided to release the 1st installment (Amount in Rs. Lakh) upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the projects

The Empowered Committee, in its 119th EC meeting accorded in-principle approval for few projects of Kamrup Assam. The State Government was requested to submit the Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) and Cost estimates for the projects. It was again considered in 120th meeting & 121st meeting of EC. Now based on the comments of EC, the State have submitted a revised cost abstract and layout for two projects of Goroimari MCB of Kamrup district of Assam.

The EC approved the following projects and decided to release the 1st instalment upto 50% of the Central share for implementation of the projects:-

(D). Manipur

The Ministry has received projects for Minority Concentration Blocks of Manipur. It has been conveyed by the State Govt. vide letter No. 20/12/2004-MOBC(Pt-I) dated 07.12.2016 that various projects proposals have been approved by the SLC in its meeting held on 10.05.2016. The State has submitted the DPR of the projects and following declaration in Appendix-II of the guidelines:

- The land for all construction activities is available.
- It has been ensured that all locations proposed have atleast 25% minority population in its catchment area.
- It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have atleast 25% enrolment of the minority students.
- The Cost estimates proposed for different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/ design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work
- No duplication of the work with any Scheme of the Center /State Government and concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- Maintenance and recurring cost related will be borne by the concerned department of State Govt.
- The plan proposal has been approved by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme/ SLSSC.

h. Mihr

During the meeting it was noticed by the Empowered Committee that representative from the concerned district were not present. The Empowered Committee considered the projects and asked for project wise details from the State representatives present during the meeting through vedio conferencing. Since, the data related to Minority population in catchment area of assets, enrolment of minority students, and justification for higher cost for assets were not readily available with the State representative, the EC in consultation with the State representative decided to consider the projects of MCBs of Manipur in next meeting of EC scheduled on 20.12.2016 and desired that during the meeting, the representative of concerned district must be present.

(E) Bihar

The State Govt. of Bihar has submitted project proposals in respect of six districts for implementation of MsDP during 12th Five Year Plan under restructured MsDP. The State Govt. has submitted the declaration in appendix-II of guidelines of MsDP for all the projects:-

- I. The cost estimates proposed for the different works/projects are as per the standardized cost derived on the basis of norms/design prescribed by the concerned Ministry for that particular work.
- II. It has been ensured that all the school where ACRs, Labs and Hostels are proposed have at least 25 % enrolment of the minority students.
- III. It has been ensured that there is no duplication of the work with any scheme of the Central Government or a State Government and the concerned Director/Mission Director has been consulted in this regard.
- IV. The land for all construction activities is available.
- V. The maintenance and the recurring cost related to the assets proposed in this plan will be borne by the State Govt.
- VI. The Plan proposal has been recommended by the State Level Committee for PM's New 15 Point Programme.

The detail of project is discussed below:-

- (1) Construction of 50 bedded & 100 bedded Hostel: Two types of hostels have been proposed by the State of Bihar. The cost of 100 bedded hostels was mentioned as Rs.273.54 lakh and the cost of 50 bedded has been worked out as Rs.240.18 lakh. The State Govt. provided the details of cost with layout. Considering the recommendation of representative of HRD and NAWADCO, the EC agreed for the project for construction of 100 bedded hostel at the cost of Rs.171.14 lakh. However in the case of project for construction of 50 bedded hostels, the EC desired that instead of approving a lum-sump cost for the project, the State may work out the cost estimate keeping in view the norms of RMSA/SSA and submit it to the Ministry so that it can be considered by EC in its next meeting. The State assured the EC that for projects approved by the EC, the State will bear any cost over and above the approved amount.
- (2) Construction of High School /Up-gradation of Middle school into High School: The State Govt. has submitted the proposal of construction of new high school/up-gradation of middle school at the unit cost of Rs.142.71 lakh. The project was discussed with the representative of M/o HRD and NAWADCO. It was informed that as per RMSA norms of upgraded high school building for class 9 to 10 only with built up area 5272.33 Sq. ft. which costs approved

is Rs. 71.88 lakh. The Pr. Secretary, Govt. of Bihar informed that in instant proposal, it is proposed to upgrade high school upto 12 Standard with built up area of 10112.00 Sq. ft. Considering the recommendation of representative of HRD and NAWADCO, the EC agreed to proposals for Construction of High School /Up-gradation of Middle school into High School at the cost of Rs. 131.00 lakh.
